These **GREENStart** packages are designed to provide support for our certification programme and, if requested, a Resource Efficiency assessment of your business. All new members commence with a GREENStart Certification service. Those businesses that wish to focus on Resource Efficiency as well should opt for the combined service.

There are 2 GREENStart Services available;

- Combined Certification and Resource Efficiency Support Service

Certification Support

The service includes a site visit where the programme and the criteria and requirements for the business will be explained. During the site visit an initial completion of some of the tools and templates and verification sheets and general documentation will be applied so that the business understands the process.

A general walk through of the site will be undertaken and some broad opportunities identified.

Certification Support & Resource Efficiency Health Check

The Certification Support service is delivered plus a detailed review of the Resource Efficiency KPI's of the business.

A focused walk through of the site will be undertaken with the intent to identify specific resource efficiency opportunities, focusing on no and low-cost actions.



Certification Support Service

The service includes a site visit where the programme and the criteria and requirements for the business will be explained. Cost

A GHP GREENStart Certification Support Service costs €995 plus VAT

What Actions do you need to do?

Prior to Site Visit

- Gather previous 12 months utility bills (Energy, Waste, Water)
- Complete as much as possible our pre-visit information schedule

During Site Visit

- Provide access to all parts of the building and plant front and back of house
- Provide any information requested to be available
- Ensure your Green Champion & Team is on hand for the site visit and overview of the Online Green Folder documentation requirements

A site visit generally takes approximately a half day and for a hotel, includes an overnight stay to enable a holistic overview to be undertaken.



Combined Certification Support Service and Resource Efficiency Health Check

This service is recommended for businesses who wish to implement our Certification Programme and as an initial Resource Efficiency assessment of your business. This service takes a full day.

The **Standard Package** is ideal any business that has utility bills (Energy, Water, Waste) **less** than €200,000 per annum.

The Enhanced Package is ideal for businesses that have utility bills in excess of €200,000 per annum.

The GREENStart Combined Standard Package includes:

- Certification Support Service
- Benchmarking Energy, Water, and Waste
- Electricity Analysis where a MCC10/Quarter Hour meter is in place
- Carbon Footprint Analysis Scope 1 & 2
- Business Operational review walk through all departments and back of house
- Overall report and cost saving recommendations with a focus on No and Low-Cost solutions
- Grant Aid and Financial Support Review
